DISCLOSURE OF REGULATIONS & SITE-SPECIFIC SAFETY TRAINING FOR ENTERING CRYSTAL MINE EVENT SITE

All Visitors age 18 and up are <u>required</u> to read these regulations and participate in this 'site-specific safety <u>training</u>' prior to entering the mine, and <u>sign a waiver of liability</u>. <u>READ ALL BEFORE YOU SIGN</u>! The following comply with Federal regulations as outlined by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA), Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), and must be followed for YOUR SAFETY.

- 1. The mine is located in an **uncontrolled wilderness environment** and Visitors agree to take **full responsibility** for their health, safety and welfare in that environment. Possible hazards may include but are not limited to: **ticks, poison ivy, briars, ants, insects, snakes, wild animals, dogs, sunburn**, **etc.**
- 2. Regarding your personal health, visitors must be in generally good health. There are occasions when visitors have experienced dizziness, light-headedness, nausea, weak knees, heaviness in chest, or other uneasy feelings. <u>If you do not feel well for any reason, sit down, and ask for help. Management reserves the right to call emergency services at visitors' expense</u>. Persons with limitations are welcome but assume full responsibility for their health and equipment. <u>Dogs MUST be tethered at all times!</u>
- 3. Visitors <u>assume full responsibility</u> for their children under age 18, possessions, vehicles and equipment. Electronic equipment has been known to malfunction upon visiting for unknown reasons. It is recommended that visitors turn off cell phones in the mine area, and use caution when operating devices.
- 4. <u>USE CAUTION</u> at the mine site. <u>WATCH YOUR STEP</u>! Restrain yourselves & children from running!
- 5. <u>NO</u> alcohol, illegal substances, or weapons are permitted in the mine. Vaping or Smoking is permitted <u>at</u> <u>the parking area ONLY</u>; <u>please do not litter!</u> Extinguish butts inside vehicles (Federal law).
- 6. Visitors agree to <u>drive on mine roads</u> only, not drive off-road, and abide by the posted <u>speed of 5 mph</u>, and to set parking breaks upon arrival. Visitors agree to not go or dig beyond <u>POSTED SIGNS</u>. (show sign)
- 7. Crystals have <u>SHARP</u> edges or points that can cause cuts. We have a <u>First-Aid kit</u> if needed. It is recommended to wear hand and/or eye protection while digging or handling crystals. <u>Do not **HAMMER**</u> rocks, ground, due to flying debris. Do <u>NOT dig under trees taller than you!</u> (Timber!)
- 8. Food and drinks may be brought; all **TRASH must be carried OUT**. **NO glass** is allowed in the mine.
- 9. In event of <u>severe weather or other emergency</u>, all Visitors will be <u>required to exit</u> the premises **IMMEDIATELY**. <u>**Do not panic or run**</u>. Gather personal belongings and return to the **STORE** for further instruction. There are <u>**NO**</u> storm safe structures on the premises. <u>In case of **LIGHTNING**</u>, shelter in car. <u>**REFUNDS**</u>: Staff may grant <u>full</u> refunds <u>before first 20 minutes</u>, no crystals may be taken if full refund
- 10. <u>In event of any emergency, call 911</u>. Report any other problems <u>immediately</u> to staff. <u>Management reserves the right to refuse service, at its discretion, to anyone for any reason at any time</u>.
- 11. <u>Upon finishing with the digging</u>, <u>STOP BY the store to check out</u>. Staff will <u>take a photo of how FULL</u> <u>the yellow bucket is</u>, then your crystals may be removed. You keep what you find! <u>Return bucket & tools.</u>
 Extra buckets OR rocks that do not fit in bucket, are charged an extra \$10 each, Thank you!
